




Centre Bounce

Correction from last week – Adelaide has "won" the wooden spoon in 2020. Port Adelaide is the only team never to receive the title. Thanks Nicholas! In 1910, two Carlton players – Doug Fraser and Alex Lang – were both found guilty of bribery, resulting in a suspension lasting 99 weeks each. This record suspension has not been witnessed since; however, North Melbourne player Fred Rutley was reported six times in one match against Geelong in 1925 – two kicking, three striking and one melee – resulting in an 89-week suspension.




